- You analyse the opponent using video and data, and translate this analysis into clear and structured insights linked to the right video clips.
- You prepare opposition analyses and safeguard a consistent methodology, focusing on structure, patterns, vulnerabilities, key players and different scenarios.

- You work closely with coaches and other analysts. You ensure that analyses are delivered on time, accurately and in line with the needs of the staff.

This makes you the ideal candidate

- Thanks to your relevant experience in football, you possess strong football-specific expertise. You are able to analyse match footage through a tactical lens, identify recurring patterns in team and player behaviour, and accurately interpret and distinguish between these patterns.
- You are analytical, structured and precise. You can process large amounts of information and reduce it to its essence. You know which information is relevant for coaches and players, and you can communicate complex insights in a simple and visually clear way.
- You are familiar with video analysis and data analysis, preferably also with relevant analysis platforms and data tools. Experience with software such as Hudl Sportscode, Wyscout, Studio or similar tools is considered an asset.
- You can work independently, while also functioning well within a multidisciplinary team. You are communicative, discreet and reliable. You understand that working in an elite sporting environment requires flexibility and that deadlines are often tight.
- You have a proactive attitude, take initiative and actively contribute ideas on how the analysis process can be further improved. You are eager to learn, open to feedback and have the ambition to continuously develop yourself.
